

MONEY FOR ART

Gallery's
\$250m gift

THE Art Gallery of NSW has secured a funding bonanza, with the state government to pump about \$250 million into a major expansion.

The government contribution to the Sydney Modern project will take care of the bulk of its overall \$344 million price tag, with the gallery to raise the remaining \$100 million itself.

Also on the cards is a \$100 million "Regional Cultural Fund" which will be used to both upgrade existing facilities throughout the bush and build new galleries.

The money will also go towards touring exhibitions and the digitisation of collections for preservation.

When framing using ready-made frames, replace the MDF board at the back with **FOAMCORE** available from Officeworks and other places. This is 'light as air' but strong and firm. It holds in your work and makes a framed work that is light and strong. Your work will be light and easier for all to handle.
