NEW VENTURE FOR QAS

THIS year's 11th Art Show in City Walk, Canberra will be surrounded by a Market which is expected to attract more people to the area and stall holders are welcome.

The stall hire will pay for the Art Marquee which has been paid for in previous years by sponsors and the use of the Defence Force tents. The committee will be looking for as many paintings as possible from members to boast the 11th Art Show and of course it is open to all artists. The interest for market stalls has been encouraging and if the combined events takes off it will be financially beneficial and help pay for Gallery improvement.

QAS has contributed \$12,000 towards the new \$120,000 gallery and the **NSW Government** plus the **Palerang Regional Council** granted the remainder.

The committee has drawn up a priority list of further needs for the gallery and 'if the 11th Art Show and Market goes well QAS will be in a good position to deliver the improvements needed. The success of last year's **\$3 Book Stall** will see another one this year and members are asked to donate and deliver good books (not Art Books) to the City Walk site and maybe buy a book or two to replace your book supply.



THE SCULPTURES ARE COMING

THE Canberra based Strathnairn Sculpture Group are moving and are going to be part of the QAS and will bolster the art in our Gallery. Jim Sullivan the Sculpture Group representative convinced the committee that their art would play a huge part in our Gallery. Not only will they be able to display and sell their works, but sculpture classes will be held, possibly at night. We will need more storage and the sculpture 'boys' are rebuilding our garden shed to make it bigger for both parties.

Another plus is they will all become members of QAS.
