CARR A CLASS OF ITS OWN

MARGARET Carr is a generous tutor who enjoys passing on her artistic knowledge to others. She has been an artist in the Canberra region for many years, gaining a well-deserved reputation for her drawing ability. Trained in art but self-taught with pencil and pen, Margaret has specialised skills to share.

Margaret recently held a Pen and Ink workshop for the Queanbeyan Art Society. There were tips on how to enhance artwork, how to make seemingly difficult things much easier. When using a pen, Margaret suggested, ensure it is waterproof, or further work with watercolour will blur the work. Margaret also demonstrated ways to make unique backgrounds as a base for pen drawing.

A portrait work was undertaken using black fine-line pen, creating the shades/tones with hatching, dots, lines. Learning when less is more and more is enough. Among the tips on different papers and their uses, Margaret explained how hand made paper can be wet on the edge and teased out to create a feathery edge for works. Overall, a most informative and enjoyable workshop. Thank you Margaret.
