WILDCARE QUEANBEYAN

Guest Speaker **Belinda Hogarth-Boyd**, President of Wildcare Queanbeyan spoke to us about the volunteer work Wildcare do to maintain a 24hr, 7 day/week service over 22,000 sq kms to help sick, injured or orphaned native Australian animals. This summer there is a huge need with very hungry, thirsty and injured animals. Wildcare are making regular food drops to bush fire burned bush, liaising with landowners or national parks to access the land.

Wildcare give medical aid and often home care to injured animals, then return them to the wild.

UNFRAMED FOR QAS GALLERY

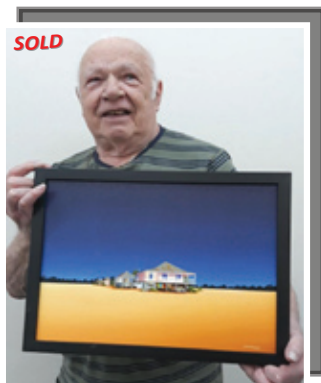

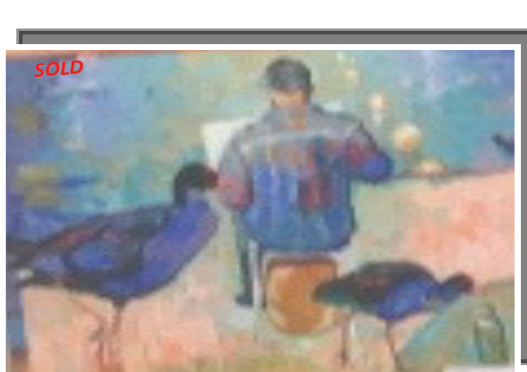

About the artist

Isla Patterson, a well-known Canberra artist is a multi-award winning watercolourist, specialising in portraying nature and life both in the Canberra region, the outback, wildlife, seascapes and overseas scenes.

She has lived in the ACT since 1979 and over this period has developed a reputation as an artist known especially for her distinctive depictions of the local scene, and although proficient in most mediums, prefers the delicacy of watercolours.

Isla began her art studies with Trevor Clare a highly regarded artist and art school tutor in Adelaide and continued for a period of three years, in the USA where she studied watercolour and pastel, joined and exhibited with the International Art Society of Washington DC and held her first solo show in Virginia, where she lived.

She has worked on many commissions such as the Canberra Times Building, Jason Placemats, the International building models at Cockington Green and has paintings in collections in Australia and overseas countries. Included in these countries are Italy, UK, USA, France, Germany, Nigeria, South Africa, Scotland, and Ireland.

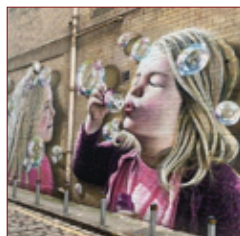
