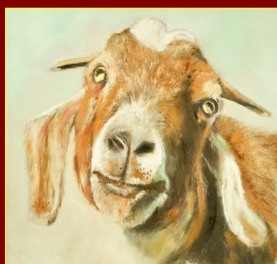

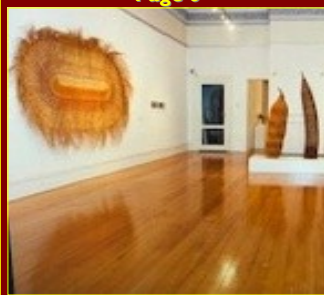

BALLIS/GREINKE EXHIBITION ZOOM OPENING

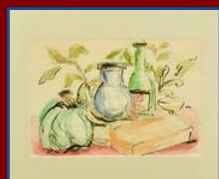

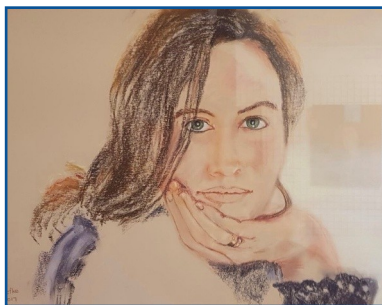

**ANIMAL PORTRAIT 3***Goofy Goat***Patricia Reynolds**

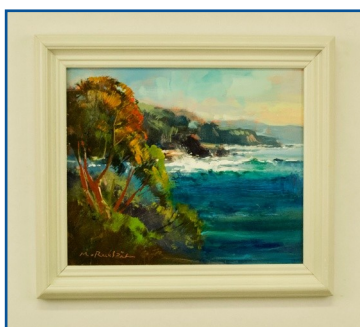
Loved the appealing expression on the goat's face. Excellent use of the medium.

QAS LIFE MEMBERS MATTER

Jill and Phil Greinke:

Jill and Phil are two excellent artists who have both played very important roles in helping the QAS to grow from a membership that had dwindled to less than ten members by around 1980, when the Queanbeyan City Council fortunately entrusted it to renovate the run-down little cottage in Trinculo Place.

QAS committee members Frank Bresnik and Mercia Kaczmarowski asked them both to join the society and do what they could, to help build up its membership.

Before coming to Canberra, Phil had been a member of the Drummoyne Art Society in Sydney and Jill a member of the Victorian Art Society.

Both of them had been successful in winning many prestigious awards. Phil had studied art at the University of NSW and Jill had been studying at the Canberra School of Art.

Once the Trinculo Place premises were in working order, after tireless work by founding member Trevor Hardy and his small band of eager helpers, Phil and Jill were responsible for commencing workshops run by visiting artists and themselves.

They increased the number of competitions for members of the society, as well as securing sponsors for these competitions, including the Queanbeyan Leagues Club and the Queanbeyan City Council. They also involved the art society in local charity work, including fund raising for the Queanbeyan Hospital.

I joined the society in the late 1980s and I can well recall Phil and Jill being responsible for a large spurt in the society's membership around that time.

Phil's weekly classes, that included the teaching of the techniques of the Old Masters, was particularly popular, attracting many of the Canberra region's best artists to the society.

Phil and Jill also organised outdoor painting days for members and I still recall our outing to a Bungendore horse racing event one day.

Both Life Members of QAS, Phil was elected President five times and both Phil and Jill were hard working members of the committee over many years.



Julie Ballis:

Julie had been interested in drawing and painting portraits since she was a little girl and she recalls drawing comic strips for her friends at school.

She studied art at the Australian Institute of Art in Sydney before she married and moved to Canberra.

After joining QAS over 30 years ago, she was fortunate to be able participate in two week-long workshops in the 1990s, run by former Archibald Prize winning artist Joshua Smith and his good friend Yve Close.

These workshops, together with her weekly practice gained by attending the Canberra Art Workshop Portrait sessions over some years, greatly improved the quality of her portrait painting.

Between 2002 and 2014 she had many paintings in annual exhibitions by Portrait Artists Australia at parliament houses in Canberra and Sydney, and at the Victorian Art Society Gallery in Melbourne.

Julie has been a finalist in the Shirley Hannan National Portrait Award.

In 2005, she was one of about 35 exhibitors in the Macquarie International/ Portrait Artists Australia Exhibition at the Australian Embassy in Washington DC.

Two of her portraits are also included in the 2012 publication 'The Artists Book, Portrait Artists Australia, Ten years'.

Julie conducted a weekly portrait class at QAS for many years and she has also run quarterly and bi-annual workshops for both QAS and the Artists' Society of Canberra over many years.

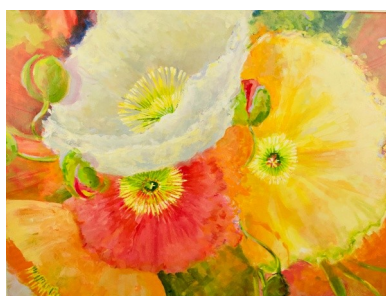
She was President of QAS for four years and she is also proud to be a life member of our society.

ANDREW IS THE WORKSHOP COORDINATOR



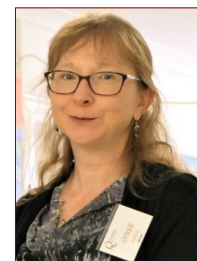

THE QAS Committee now has a new Exhibition entry idea for the intake for exhibitions (the office) and it appears to be working well.

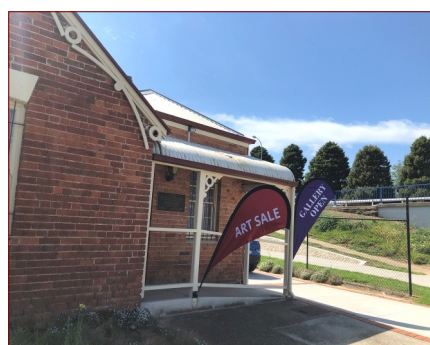

sponsors because the QAS policies are to present as much as possible for members in each monthly event.

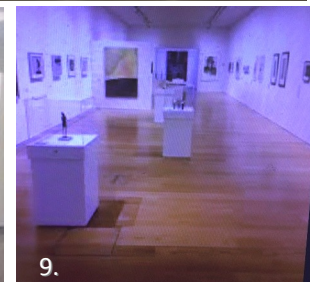
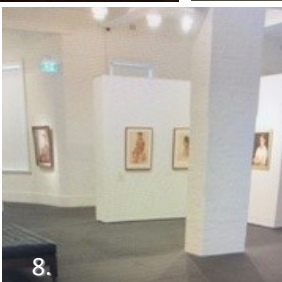
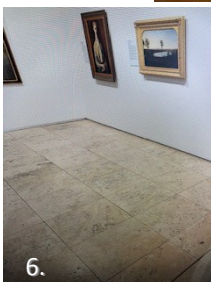
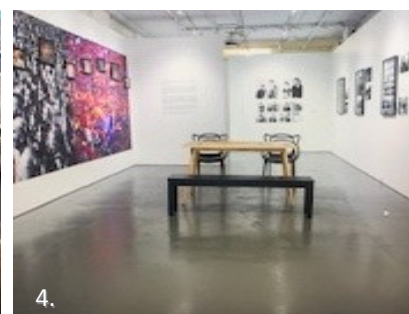
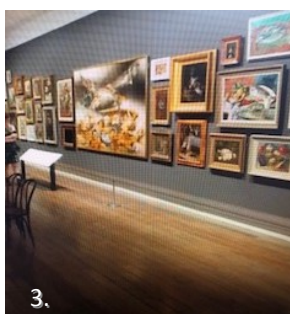

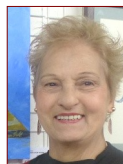
THE QAS Library is in need of 'good' novels to sell to members and visitors to the QAS Gallery.
