The Committee agreed it was time to look for a new floor covering, more suitable to the Members & Visitors to the Gallery. We obtained four quotes from different companies & four different products to find the most suitable for our purposes. Information was provided as to durability, stain resistance and life span.

The Committee agreed to accept the quote from Lemons Floor Coverings to supply and install 3mm Blackbutt Polaris vinyl planks. Some preparation work was necessary to even up the existing floor.

The installer 'Dennis' is a very good craftsman, who laid the entire floor by himself over 3 days.

We are very pleased with the professional result and we would highly recommend 'Lemons Floor Coverings Carpets & Blinds'. We also had our new blinds fitted at the same time from the same company.
