

TIME FOR QAS HISTORIAN

IT is time the Queanbeyan Art Society looked to having a Society Historian because our history would paint a wonderful picture of many members' endeavours!

The land on which the cottage (gallery) stands was originally purchased by Mrs Emma Rowley (nee Hunt) who arrived in the colony in 1832 and who came to Queanbeyan in the early 1840's. The cottage was built in the year 1880 by Samuel Austin and William Moore for John James Wright (1821 – 1904), Queanbeyan's first M.P (1874 1877), and first Mayor (1885).

The Art Society has had some wonderful volunteers over many years and hopefully names and photos can be found to paint the picture!




