David worked in art galleries and museums for most of his career, covering curatorial and collections management roles at the National Gallery of Australia, National Library, National Film and Sound Archive, National Museum, and the Queensland University Art Museum. Following three years as Curatorial Manager of the National Portrait Gallery, David oversaw grant programs for the Australia-wide touring of visual arts and museum exhibitions, and for touring performing arts productions, for the Federal Arts Department. For the last eight years he has been a Voluntary Guide at the National Gallery. Guiding both adults and children in exhibitions ranging from Tom Roberts, to Monet, to Matisse and Picasso; and from Cartier jewellery, to American Contemporary Masters, to the arts of the Pacific. David has qualifications in art history, anthropology and project management.





It is pleasing our society is in a strong position financially, membership support and growth in our art.





QAS Workshop Co-ordinator, Andrew Smith, has assembled an exciting program of art workshops for 2022.

After two years of Covid cancellations Andrew has negotiated to bring back many of the postponed workshops from 2021 and added some popular workshop tutors to run extra workshops. When Andrew cancelled last years workshops, he advised those who were booked and paid that they would be given priority access to the rescheduled workshops in 2022. This was considered fair given the circumstances of the cancellations were outside the control of the registered participants and in most cases they had purchased their workshop materials. Hence, those courses marked (RESERVED) are not open to all members in the first instance, they are reserved for 2021 members registered on those workshops for a 2 week period until 17 December. Following that date an announcement of any vacancies will be made to all members and general bookings will be opened.



I began art studies in the late 1960's in South Australia with Trevor Clare, who had been a lecturer at the Adelaide School of Arts and went painting up in the Flinders Ranges with Hans Heyson the renowned watercolour artist. I studied watercolour with Ruth Tuck and joined the S.A. Art Society. Also did 2 years drawing and design with the dept. of Further Education Tafe.

I lived in the USA from 1975 until 1978, continued watercolour studies, did 2 years pastel portraiture, joined the International Artist Society in Washington DC and held my first solo exhibition.

I settled in the ACT in 1979, joined ASOC, AGRA in Melbourne, Queanbeyan Art Society and later AIM the miniature group. I studied portraiture, and life drawing at the National Capital Art School adult classes and went out painting landscapes once a week, firstly with Peg Minty's group and then ventured widely around the countryside mainly with Margaret Carr.

I was on the ASOC committee organising and hanging exhibitions, organised exhibitions for Cranleigh School and gave lessons and set up an exhibition for the MS Society.

Some commissions were paintings for Jason Placemats, paintings of the international building models at Cockington Green, The Canberra Times Building and 36 Embassies in the ACT for a book written by Dorothy Hart titled International Treasures. The book was launched at the National Library in September 2017 by former-Governor General Michael Jeffries.

I have had many solo exhibitions and won many awards some being

ASOC W/c 1997, Open Prize 1981, Peg Minty award 2009, portrait Prize 2015.

Canberra Show Champion painting 1982.

Jindabyne Ex. W/c 2006, best in show 2016, w/c 2022.

Cooma Art Gallery, Raglan. First prize 2003, miniature 2007, John Briscoe Award 2016, W/c 2022.

Queanbeyan Leagues Club, Q. City Council, Q.A.S. Molonglo River EX. Best 2016, Royal Melbourne Show and Agra, Melbourne.

I Have paintings in many overseas countries including a large work of St. Mark's Cathedral Venice at The Australian Embassy in Italy.
