
A GIFT FORM OUR NEIGHBOURS

- recycle, reuse, repurpose, renew things we have made or built in the urban, rural and natural landscape.


I encourage you to explore these ideas as you create your artworks.





Watercolour and Ink on Yupo Paper with Renowned Local Artist Maxine Sumner

THE Queanbeyan Art Society successful one-day workshops on paper with the renowned local workshops focused on providing techniques for using Yupo paper, endless possibilities for artistic

recently hosted two highly watercolour and ink on Yupo artist **Maxine Sumner**. The participants with valuable tips and a unique plastic paper that offers expression.

Yupo paper, known for its face, presents a unique challenge and opportunity for artists working with watercolours and inks. Maxine Sumner, an expert in the medium, shared her knowledge and expertise with participants, guiding them through the process of creating stunning artworks on Yupo paper.

During the workshops, participants learned about the specific techniques required to work with Yupo paper, including the application and manipulation of watercolours and inks. Congratulations to those who sold cards this time around and happy card making everyone.



JOSEPHINE TANTON


I decided to take up painting after my retirement from the ANU. I had worked with textiles for many years and although I still have a passion in this area I wanted to try something new. I tried several different media before discovering pastel in 2009. Immediately I felt that pastels were the ideal medium for my artistic ability.

I was encouraged to develop my skills when I joined ASOC in 2013 and have been a member of QAS for several years. I'm grateful for the advice and encouragement the people in both groups have given me. I have completed several workshops with master pastelists.

I love pastels because they are so tactile, the versatility of colour and the different effects that can be achieved by layering and using different strokes.

Although I have travelled overseas extensively most of the paintings in this exhibition were motivated by trips around Australia. The colour and texture of the rocks and beautiful Australian landscape provided the inspiration.




