QAS 2023 WORKSHOPS

Queanbeyan Art Society wrapped up its 2023 workshop series with an exciting artistic exploration led by the accomplished local Canberra artist, Leigh D Walker. The workshop, aptly titled "A Journey Through the Layers," provided participants with a unique foray into the world of acrylic paint.

Under Leigh's expert guidance, attendees delved into a transformative process of layering, employing stumbling and glazing techniques to navigate from dark to light. The workshop unfolded in two distinct segments, beginning with the intricate depiction of a Lily flower. Participants learned to establish a dark base layer and, through thoughtful layering, breathe life into their floral creations.

In the second part of the workshop, the artistic journey expanded to encompass landscapes, with a special emphasis on depicting a major river. The layering techniques, now familiar to the participants, took on new dimensions as they translated their newfound skills into immersive landscapes.

Leigh D Walker's artistic expertise were evident throughout the workshop, creating an environment where creativity thrived. As the Queanbeyan Art Society bids farewell to its 2023 workshop series, the echoes of "A Journey Through the Layers" linger, a testament to the ten unique workshops that is helping QAS power artistic exploration within the community.

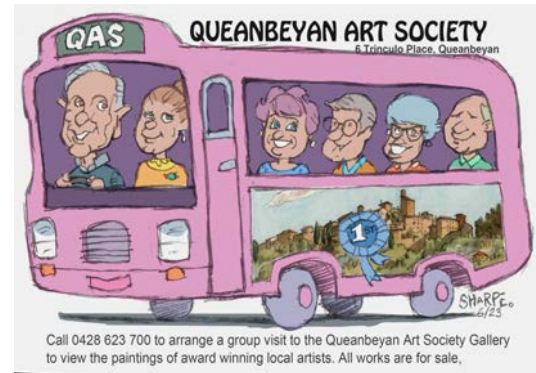
WARRIGAL ON THE ART BUS

GRANTS FOR QAS GALERY

Growing QAS in 2023

Over 2023 the Art Society has been focused on the refurbishing and improving of the gallery building. Since the 1980's when the derelict gallery was restored by QAS, QCC and other volunteer labour eg Rotoract, there has not been such a concentration on the gallery internally. **QAS are very grateful for a NSW**

Government grant with which to do this needed work.

With QPRC recommended tradesmen working at the gallery the following works have been completed:

New down lighting throughout

New wiring and relocating and tidying outdated wiring.

New down lights with dimmers, for better lighting for Life Drawing and Sculpture with art models.

New outdoor coach lights on the bridge side.

Repaired leaking roof, damaged ceiling plaster replaced with plaster to be painted soon.

Kitchen ceiling modernised with plaster over roof beams, new insulation, New down lights.

Skylight repaired in Oil paintings room.

New wide accessible ramp/path from driveway gate to workroom door, easier for Anyone on wheels eg walkers, prams, etc

Workroom doors new door handles complying with fire safety rules.

New manholes in 2 front rooms to allow roof access

New more powerful air conditioner in the back workroom.

Roof leak repaired in back workroom, this week and before Christmas.



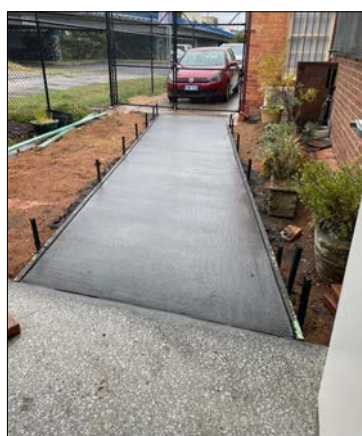

Our list is long and peppered with award winners. We have still life and landscape painters, expressionists and cross over artists. I am proud to be in their company.

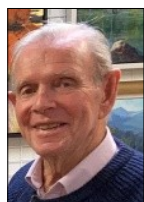
