FOR an entry fee of **\$20**, payable to QAS, you will receive a 16 inch diameter, round, craft wood circle on which to paint. **There is no specific theme.** It can be anything you imagine the dinners in the Barrel Room would find pleasing, as they sit and enjoy their delicious meals, prepared by the chef at Lerida Estate.

You can purchase your craft wood circle from the gallery during the Opening of the Queanbeyan Leagues Club Exhibition from 1pm on 4 August.

At this stage there will only be one board per artist but hopefully more boards will be available well before the **entry date of 28 September.**

Obviously, the craft wood circles lend themselves to oil and acrylic paint, however with a little imagination other mediums are possible.

The wooden circles will be attached to the barrels using velcro so they can be easily removed without damage to the barrels. This will be done as the boards are being hung. Paintings will be judged, and Lerida meal voucher prizes awarded. **First prize \$200, 2nd prize \$150, 3rd prize \$100.**

All works will be for sale at a common price of \$150, so please include the usual information you would provide for a QAS exhibition on a label attached to the back, to enable a room sheet to be prepared. All commission on the sale of the paintings will go to the Queanbeyan Art Society

Paintings will need to be submitted to the QAS gallery no later than Saturday 28 September 2024.

These can be dropped off during Gallery opening hours.

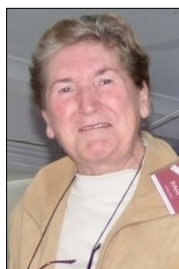

ACTIONS ACHIEVED 2023 & 2024

Air Conditioner: New 8kw Air conditioner- replaced 5kw air conditioner

Building works: New kitchen ceiling installed and new ceiling insulation
Privacy door lock sets to 2 toilets, new door sets/handles to workroom gallery
Water leak in ceiling repaired, new plaster installed
New accessible ramp built in front courtyard for access from gate to workroom
Skylight tube/s repaired OIL room
Stratco kit cupboard assembled and installed workroom verandah.
Leaking Gutter in roof between Working gallery and Oil Display room repaired/rebuilt.
Rehang existing external front door to workroom to open other way for ease of access via new ramp path.

Electrical Works: LED down lights installed with dimmer switches.
Power Circuit with RCD supplied & installed into the switchboard for extra power points.
New Power points TV's, front door & Security alarm
Light Switch for the front door –upgraded and new front porch light
Re route the alarm panel power and code pad cabling near the front door to replace ugly ducting
LED Emergency lights - supplied and installed. LED Emergency Exit lights -
External coach lights purchased and installed with sensors for night lighting
Power Circuit with RCD supplied & installed into the switchboard for the new A/C unit including some conduit install
All power points labelled and tested

Members I would ask you to take pamphlets at the Gallery and hand them out on Gallery hours.

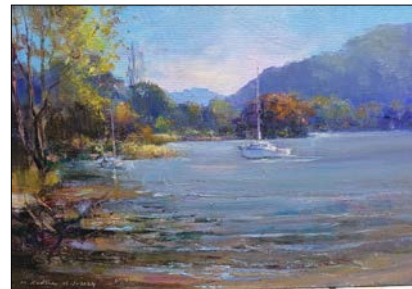
