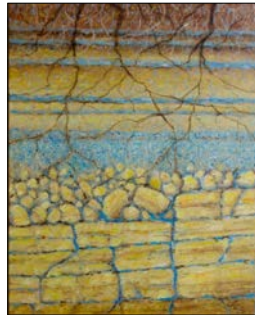

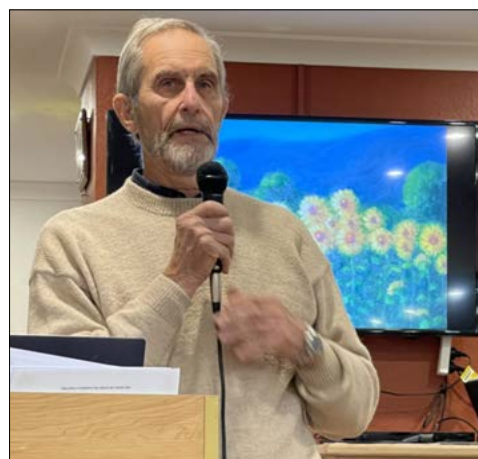

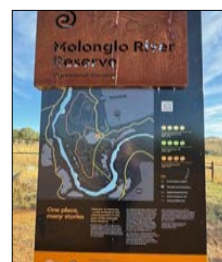

Membership Fees

At its recent meeting, the QAS Committee resolved to discontinue the practice of charging new members only \$25 for the remainder of a membership year after February. This decision was partly prompted by existing members who delayed paying their annual fees until after February and subsequently paid only \$25, which deviated from the original intent of this arrangement.

In the future, the Membership Officer will exercise discretion when dealing with new members. If a new member joins near the end of a current year, the Membership Officer will include the remainder of the current membership year in addition to the 12 months of the following year, for the \$45 fee.

Monthly Competitions

The Committee reviewed the entry fees for monthly competitions and resolved that in the future, the non-member entry fee will be \$20, applicable to both non-members and non-financial members. Entry fees for monthly competitions, per painting, will be as follows:

Gallery painters: \$5

Other financial members: \$10

Non-financial members and non-members: \$20

Paintings exceeding 1 meter in width, including the frame, will be charged an additional \$5.00.

A miniature painting is defined as one measuring 10 x 10 cm, and two miniature paintings will be permitted for the aforementioned entry fees.

Furthermore, it was agreed that in the future, non-members will be able to participate in all of the Society's competitions, eliminating the distinction between member-only and non-member-only competitions. The sole exception to this will be the Gallery Painters section of any monthly competitions, which will remain exclusive to members who regularly attend a weekly gallery session. This decision was made in the interest of attracting more entries to the regular monthly competitions and potentially increasing membership among non-members.

It's time to purchase your wooden circles and paint them for the 2025 Barrel Painting Exhibition at the **Lerida Estate Winery**.

Wooden circles are available from the Gallery for \$10. Alternatively, paint over your previous year's work. There will be a separate \$10 entry fee for the exhibition.

Paintings should be submitted at the QAS monthly exhibition entry days in July, August, and September. The deadline for submitting paintings is September 27, 2025.

All paintings will be priced at \$150, with QAS retaining 20% of the sales price. **Last year, 23 paintings were sold.**

Let's see if we can exceed that number!

The exhibition will run for six months, with unsold paintings returned to the QAS gallery in March 2026.

The Lerida Estate staff will judge the exhibition, and prizes will be announced and awarded at a morning tea hosted at the Lerida Estate in early October 2025.

The theme is open, and to provide some guidance, despite wine and food themes being popular, they were not the biggest sellers with landscapes, bird, and animal paintings amongst the more popular.

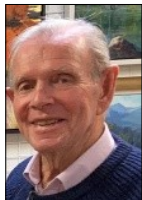
