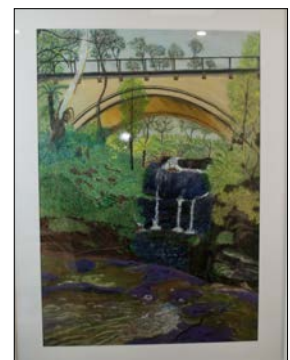

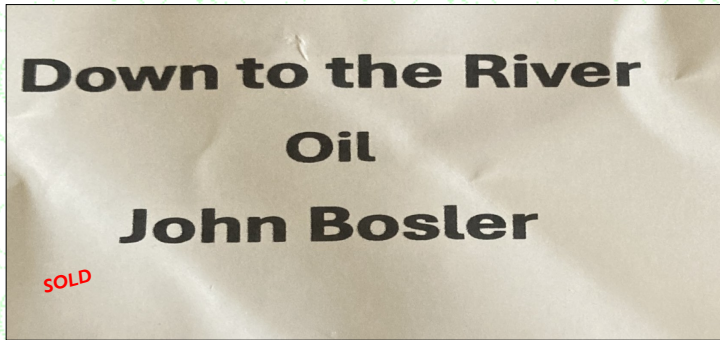

THANKS everyone for being in touch when I when through having COVID, all good now . I think why I had little trouble with it was because I had all my needles up to date.

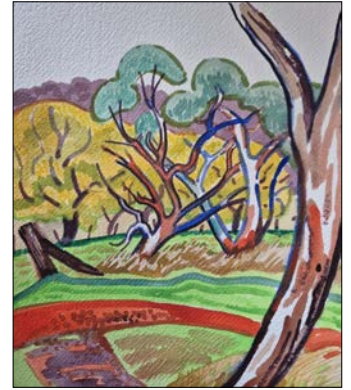

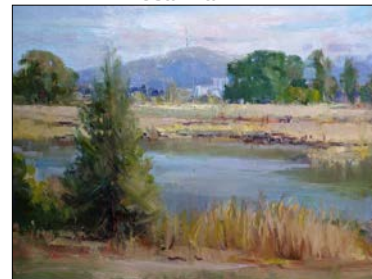

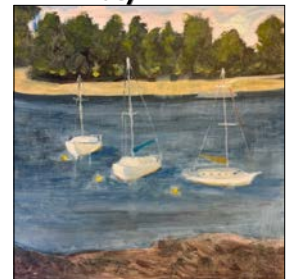

A MEMBERS INTRODUCTION INTO ART

MEMBERS are asked to tell your art story by filling this space with a photo for the Newsletter and if it becomes popular two articles a month will be published.

The first member to give a 'quick snapshot' into his introduction to art is QAS President Barry Cranston.

"I was introduced into art in the 70's when a Alderman on the Goulburn City Council and the Goulburn Art Society asked all the Aldermen to do a painting so they could hold a Art Auction to raise funds.

They gave us a board about a foot and a half square, acrylic paint and a brush as thick as you thumb and told us, if you cannot paint something just do noughts and crosses but you must sign it so we can sell you work.

I was a journalist at the time and thought that this painting experience could be like writing a story in paint.

A friend told me I had to put an undercoat on the board and she asked me what would I like to paint? I remember putting my arms over my head saying I would like to paint a big strong gum tree with a moving sky not just a blue sky. So I set out to 'attack' the board to make my master piece and try as I would it keep changing almost before my eyes.

To cut a long story short my painting turned out to be 'a dead tree in the desert' and I could not capture the 'big strong gum tree'. I said if this art can change my strong hand and my strong mind I wanted more of it.

My first tutor was Jim Curry from Crookwell and I drove out once a week and became a **Tom Roberts** admirer. With some of my charging bits in me I have tried most subjects and enjoyed the challenges.

The photo shows me making my mark Peter William's Kentucky Derby painting. I believe art brings out the true colour of our creativeness in us all know matter what palette we use".

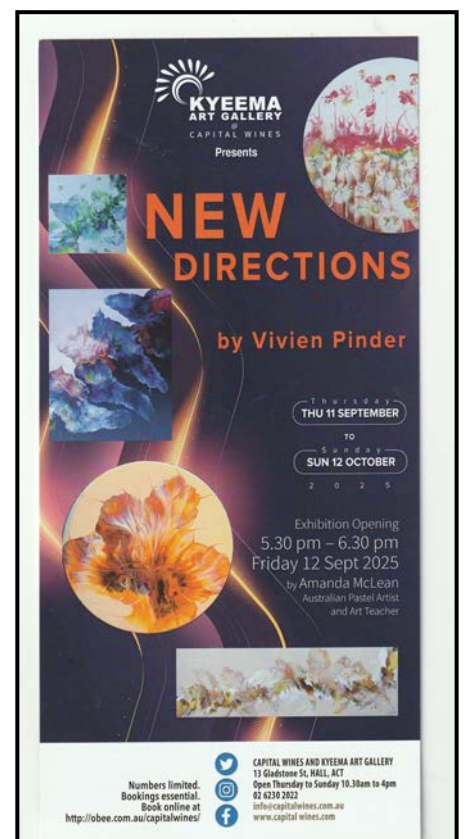

Introduction to Sketchbook

I have found myself doing a lot of waiting in my retirement and don't always have my sketchbook with me, but I do have my phone. So, I downloaded the free app Sketchbook, available on Android and IOS phones. I did add a few extra tools for a once only \$5 fee. The main menu (top left of screen) has a support option which is very helpful and easy to navigate.

You only need your fingers to draw, just like the artist who won the People's Choice Award winner at this year's Archibald Prize.

Here is a quick summary of the opening screen to get you started:



QAS SURVEY

Overall Analysis of the QAS Member Survey Overall Comment We received a total of 90 responses from our members, which, based on 200 "paid up" members, is a 45% response rate. This is well above the average, as many organisational or club surveys see response rates between 20% and 40%. This indicates that the Queanbeyan Art Society has a strong engagement, an involved membership where our members care about the Society's direction and activities. It also means our survey results are likely to be quite representative of the full membership's views—giving us a solid foundation for decisions and improvements.

Response to Individual Questions Q1. How satisfied are you with the Queanbeyan Art Society? 94% of respondents report being "very satisfied" or "satisfied" with the Society. No-one reported dissatisfaction (0% dissatisfied/very dissatisfied).

Q2. How satisfied are you with the monthly competitions including the topics? 75.87% positive ~23% neutral, 2% dissatisfied to very dissatisfied *Interpretation:* Competitions are popular but about a quarter of members are neutral—possible area for refreshing topics/formats.

Q3. How satisfied are you with the classes/work groups that are run each week? 54% positive, 43% neutral, 2.5% dissatisfied *Interpretation:* These classes do not ignite strong excitement for nearly half the membership; suggests opportunity for review, reinvigoration, or better communication about benefits.

Q4. How satisfied are you with the Annual program of courses? 70% positive, 28.5% neutral, 1% dissatisfied *Interpretation:* Generally well-received, but again, a notable neutral contingent who might want new or different courses.

Q5. How satisfied are you with your opportunity to be involved in the Society's activities? 89% positive, 11% neutral, 0% negative *Interpretation:* Members feel strongly that opportunities exist to get involved—this is a real strength.

6. & 7. Open-Ended Feedback & Engagement High number of comments and suggestions: Dozens of comments on each question and 56 suggestions for improvement—shows people are invested in the Society, want to see it succeed, and feel comfortable sharing their thoughts.

8. & 9. Age and Gender Demographics Age: Over 82% are 61+ years old; only 2 under 45. *Implication:* Membership is heavily weighted to seniors; this could be interpreted as a potential need/benefit for outreach to younger artists to ensure Society's future. Gender: 70% women, 26% men, 3% prefer not to say. *Implication:* Women are the clear major demographic. Programming might consider interests and needs accordingly, but also ensuring inclusiveness.

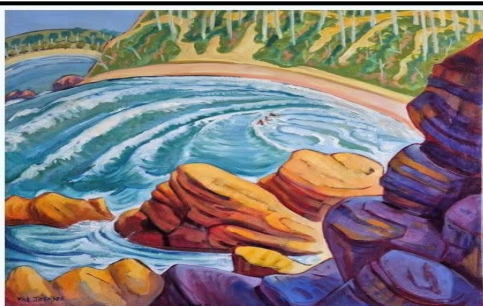
