We had 4 days of fabulous workshops with our Watercolour tutor Chan Dissanayake in August 2025 and here is the Workshop report that can be cut to size as required but the helper recognition is very important. August Workshops with Tutor and Chan Dissanayake The Queanbeyan Art Society hosted two inspiring watercolour painting workshops in August, led by esteemed artists Tutor and local watercolourist Chan Dissanayake. These sessions attracted a vibrant mix of members and non-members eager to develop their skills in this challenging yet rewarding medium. Participants benefited greatly from the expert guidance of the tutor, who generously shared his techniques and insights. The workshops provided a supportive environment where artists of varying experience explored new approaches, honed their brushwork, and expanded their creative confidence.

Queanbeyan Art Society members helped us to ensure the workshops left a lasting impression on all attendees. A BIG thankyou to all the helpers, including Suzzane, Gayle, Oliver who looked after cleaning, catering and other admin duties and John Mudford who also did lots of handyman tasks fixing tables and chairs and making the gardens look great.

Feedback was overwhelmingly positive, with many attendees remarking on the high calibre of instruction and the friendly, encouraging atmosphere. Our visiting non members were especially complementary of the quality of the whole workshop program and will be back for more workshops in 2026.

The outstanding success of these workshops is a testament to the dedication of the tutor and the enthusiasm of the Queanbeyan art community. Our next workshops are in October and November with the bonnie Leigh Walker, another local but outstanding artist and tutor.

We still have vacancies in both of these workshops, but you will need to get in quick. Go to Humanitix to book online. The Society looks forward to hosting more such enriching events in 2026, with Chan doing watercolour and acrylic workshops, Catherine Hammilton running Colour mixing and drawing workshops and Colley Whisson will be back with three oil painting workshops. Further workshops will be announced shortly.

ART IN THE QAS GARDEN

Dear QAS Members

Our Queanbeyan Art Society has some exciting news, we are running a full weekend OPEN GALLERY Exhibition we're calling 'Art in the Garden' on Saturday 18 and Sunday 19 October as part of QPRC's (the Council's) 2025 Queanbeyan Arts Trail tourism event.

This will be a much bigger event than in past years and we will need your help to make it a fantastic weekend.

Our 'Art in the Garden' Event - We asking our QAS artists to come along for a few hours each to help make this a fantastic event for our locals and visiting tourists.

We will be partnering with our neighbouring Mexican Restaurant with its outdoor seating area that overlooks the Queanbeyan River and the park. And they will be offering a 20% discount of all food and drink on their menu to all Queanbeyan Arts Trail visitors for the whole weekend.

Our Art- We'll be showcasing our best and brightest art, which will be displayed inside our gallery, in our back courtyard hanging on wire fences, out the front of our gallery and around 3 sides of the Cartel Taqueria Mexican Restaurant next door.

All our artwork will be for sale, with the usual 20% commission collected by QAS. There will be no entrance fee for the art brought in specially for this 'Art in the Garden' event, but we will need a registration and numbering process. We'll share specific details later on.

Music - We will have a mix of background live music, in 1 hour sets from 10am to 3pm on both days, alternating between inside and outside our gallery.

Working Artists- we will have our QAS artists creating art at their easels and tables, in shifts, all weekend with everyone happy to talk to our gallery visitors.

In the back workroom and back courtyard-our group of have our regular gallery artists working in 4 groups morning and afternoon each day.

Out the front of the gallery- Kay's life drawing Monday group will set up with sketching and painting both portraits and full body pictures of their regular Monday afternoon model (who'll be fully clothed in a colourful robe). The artists will take turns and work in shifts. They will have a wire fence behind them with their best life drawing and painting work displayed.

Out the front of the Mexican Restaurant -overlooking the Queanbeyan River and around the side overlooking the park and the restaurant diners, we will have our Plein Air artists painting and sketching at their easels and chairs . They will be working in shifts to make sure there are always a few artists working all the time. With great examples of their Plein Air artworks display on both sides of wire fences around the front and side of the restaurant all for sale, close to where they are painting.

Around the restaurant seating area-looking onto the tables we will have examples of our most colourful contemporary artworks hanging on wire fences. With one or two contemporary artists at work just next to this fence. The QPRC have offered to supply art supplies (paper and pencils) for restaurant guests to create their own art while enjoying a cocktail and taco sitting at tables.

We will be showcasing in our 'Art in the Garden' gallery exhibition:

- 1. October 'Young Artist Exhibition' and QAS Member Black and White Exhibition in the front two gallery spaces.**
- 2. A selection of the best of QAS sculpture group's small works and any glass sculptures displayed on**
- 3. In the bastands throughout this gallery space.ck gallery and workroom walls we'll display a selection of our QAS artists best artworks grouped together by medium or type of art eg: watercolours on 1 wall, pastels on another wall, miniatures on another wall, prints on another, mixed media on another, seascapes on another with still life on another wall.**
- 4. In our back courtyard on wire fencing we'll display our outback landscape scenes on one space, our local Queanbeyan urban scenes on another, our local Queanbeyan Canberra natural landscape scenes on another etc.**

In our back courtyard we will also have a selection of large contemporary metal sculptures from a fantastic local Queanbeyan district artist David Smith, who's joining us as a new member.

Cleanout - To make this open gallery exhibition work, we plan to be clearing out as much as we can from our gallery and back workroom, moving our gift items shop into back of our entrance room, and removing all uncollected artworks from throughout the gallery. This will need to happen before we can set up this open gallery exhibition.

Volunteers – we'll need as many volunteers as possible in lots of roles other than being an artist at work. Including setting up, help with art registrations, art sales, logistics, security and packing up, and bringing the fences of artworks inside on the Saturday afternoon and moving them outside again on the Sunday morning. We'll also be looking for people who can lend us and tents, just in case we need to shelter from any bad weather. Marketing – will be done mainly by the QPRC, our local Council, but we'll need to do a bit ourselves. We will asking all our members to spread the word. Lets all get together and make this weekend a fantastic success, where we showcase and promote our wonderful QAS community, our talents and sell lots and lots of our art.

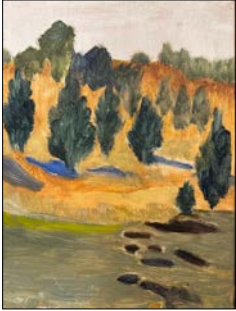

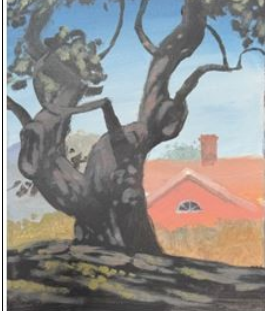

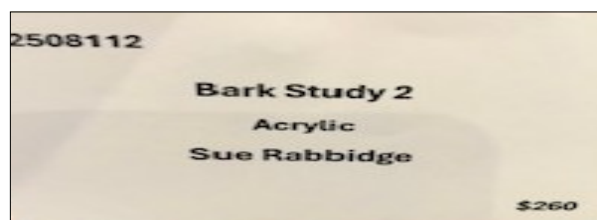
